1. I had to relieve the inner tension that was present in the spiritual life during the seventies and eighties.

This inner tension pressed me for visual form.

2. The answer for this took me ten years of delete.

3. The most difficult task was to decide on the technical solutions of the would-be tapestry.

4. In the end I decided to use only the three ancient and traditional methods: baseless "hashure", seven-ground line-raster and four fibers color mixing.

5. During the weaving process I kept out the improvisations dictated by sudden emotions.

6. The work is going on and will be finished to reserve and find his place in our spiritual spaces. I am waiting, I have time.

I recommend this “treaties” as my third part of masterwork.

Instead of giving charts and diagrams I decided to execute this study as a reach cavalcade of texts and illustrations, trusting in the strengths and effects of the pictures. Hopefully this visual “roundabout” will starts the series of associations.

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
